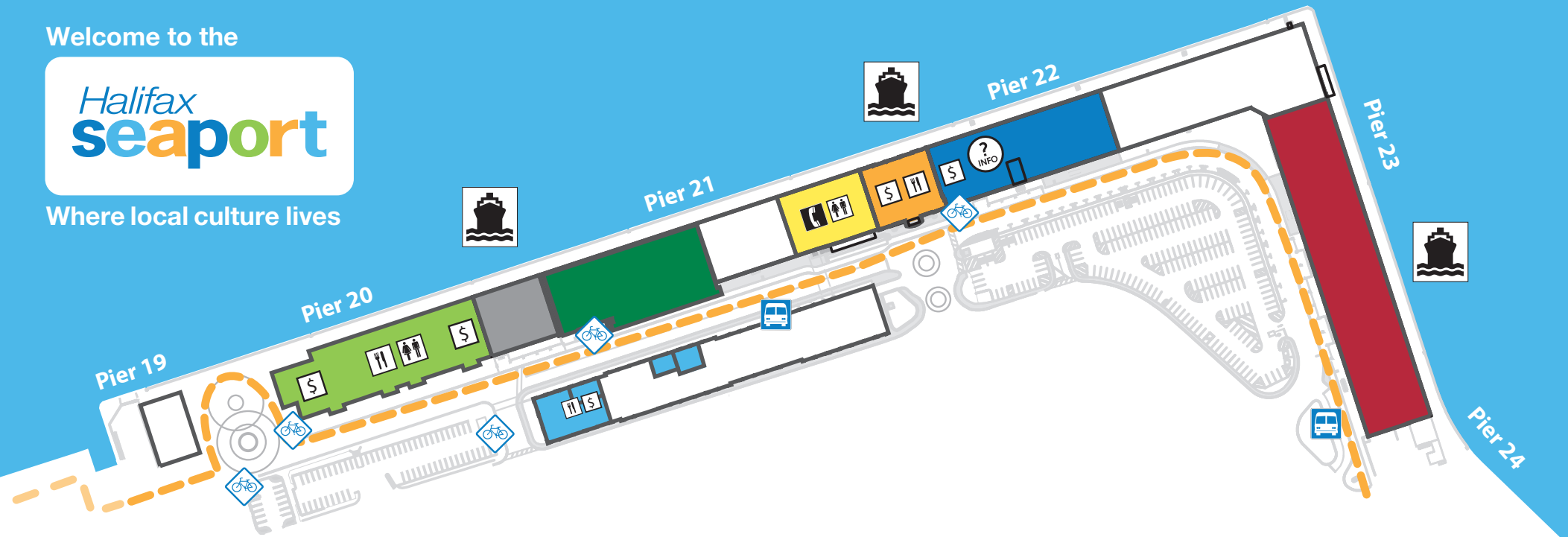

## Visitor Site Map





